## Our Itinerary:

#### Day 1 • Paris

This afternoon we will be transferred from the Charles de Gaulle Airport to our Hotel in Paris, Hotel Edouard 7.

The evening is free to explore.

## Day 2 • Paris

This morning after breakfast we attend a private Mass at the Chapel of the Miraculous Medaille. The rest of the day is at leisure.

## Day 3 • Paris

After breakfast at our hotel, we depart Paris by train to Lourdes.

This afternoon we will be greeted at the Lourdes Train Station and driven to our hotel the Grand Hotel Gallia and londres, centrally located and facing part of the Sanctuary. After we have checked in to our hotel, we enjoy a walking tour of the Sanctuary and the Grotto. Welcome Dinner in our hotel.

Note: Pilgrims are also welcome to attend the daily evening Mass followed by a 9:00p.m.group Procession. (Breakfast / Dinner)

## Day 4 • Lourdes

Enjoy an early light breakfast in our hotel followed by a walk to the Grotto. This morning we attend a private Mass at the Grotto. Later this morning we attend the International Mass in the Sacristy of St Pius X Basilica.

After lunch (on our own) we visit Lourdes' historic Castle and follow the Scenic Path of Bernadette.

This evening we enjoy dinner in our hotel. Note: The Baths are open from 9 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.This afternoon you may choose to follow the Via Crucis path. Pilgrims are also welcome to attend the daily evening Mass followed by a 9:00p.m.group Procession. (Breakfast / Dinner)





## Day 5 • Lourdes - San Sebastián - León

After breakfast we leave in our motor coach for San Sebastián.

Our local guide will greet us in San Sebastián and take us on a ½ day walking tour of the city's historic quarter and San Sebastián's main historic sites which will include the Church of Santa Maria del Coro and San Vicente Church. We will also enjoy a panoramic ride along La Concha Promenade en route to the panoramic high viewpoint overlooking the city and its bay.

After lunch in a local restaurant in the historic quarter, we continue to León where we will spend the next 2 nights at the centrally located Hotel within walking distance to all sites.

## Day 6 • Leon

After breakfast, we will visit the city including a tour of León's majestic Cathedral before our private Mass, at the Cathedral's Chapel of the Pilgrim of the Virgin. We continue the walking tour of León; visit La Casa Botines, designed by master architect Antonio Gaudi, followed by the Basilica of St. Isidoro, the Sistine Chapel and Royal Pantheon. We will learn that León is also part of the Silver Route and The Way of Saint James. León's La Ronda and Los Pasos Processions, as well as religious floats during Easter Week, have attracted international religious visitors. We will also visit the Pulchra Leonina and the Old Hospital of San Marcos, now the Parador, examples of the historic sites that this city offers. Lunch is at the Parador of San Marcos. (Breakfast / Lunch)

## Day 7 • León - Samos – Santiago de Compostela

Enjoy breakfast in our hotel. Then we travel to Santiago de Compostela. En route to Santiago, we will stop in the historic town of Samos home of the beautiful Benedictine Monastery of San Julian de Samos, and a must stop for pilgrims following the path of El Camino. We tour the Benedictine Monastery of San Julian de Samos, followed by a private Mass

Lunch is in a popular restaurant in Samos. We continue to Santiago where we will spend the next 2 nights at the historic Hotel Monument of San Francisco. The rest of the late afternoon/evening is at leisure.

## Day 8 • Santiago de Compostela

After breakfast, we enjoy a walking tour of Santiago's famous open market and historic quarter surrounding the Cathedral of Santiago. We continue with a tour of the Cathedral where we will learn of its historic importance before attending the daily Pilgrims Mass, including the spectacular Botafumeiro, in the Cathedral of Santiago. After Mass we will visit the Pilgrims Center, and conclude our visit with a walking tour of the Cathedral's roof offering panoramic views.

This evening enjoy a tour of the historic Parador Dos Reyes, followed by a special dinner.

(Breakfast / Dinner)



Day 9 • Santiago de Compostela - Pontevedra - Tui - Fátima

After breakfast we depart for Fátima. En route to Portugal, we will first stop in Pontevedra, home of the Blessed Virgin of the Pilgrim Church and a historic quarter dating back to the 11th century. We attend a private Mass to be held in the Chapel of the Virgin of the Apparitions. In Pontevedra, we will enjoy a walking tour of the Historic Quarter. We continue to Tui, where we will visit its cathedral and historic Quarter. Lunch is at the Parador. We travel to Fátima where we will spend the next 2 nights at the Hotel Estrela de Fátima. Buffet dinner in our hotel. (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

#### Day 10 • Fátima

After breakfast, we will tour the Sanctuary, Chapel and Cathedral and the Casa de los Pastores in Aljustrel, the original village where the Shepherds lived. Then we return to our hotel for a buffet lunch. Mass this afternoon is at the Chapel of the Apparitions. Buffet dinner in our hotel. This evening we join the pilgrims for the daily evening Procession and Rosary. (Breakfast / Buffet Lunch / Dinner)



### Day 11 • Fátima - Lisbon

After breakfast in our hotel, we attend a private Mass at the Chapel of the Resurrection inside the New Basilica. We depart by motor coach for Lisbon with a stop at the Monastery of Batalha built during the 14th century, followed by the Monastery of Santa Maria d'Alcobaça. We continue to Lisbon where we will spend the next 2 nights at the Altis Avenida Hotel. En route, we will have sumptuous lunch at a local restaurant. (Breakfast / Lunch)

## Day 12 • Lisbon

After breakfast we transfer to the Church of San Antonio to attend a private Mass to be held at the Church of San Antonio. Then we enjoy a panoramic tour and visit of the main historic sites of Lisbon, including the Monument of the Americas, and the San Jeronimo Monastery and the Tower of Belem. We continue on a

and Alfama Castle.

This evening we enjoy a farewell dinner accompanied by the archetypal sounds of 'Fado' poetic songs.
