Day 1 USA/ Shannon

We depart for Shannon, Ireland.

Day 2 Shannon/ Killarney/ Cork

Cead Mile Failte "Welcome to Ireland. Travel to the 1480 Dysert O'Dea Castle housing extensive museum, with various exhibitions. We will also see the ruins at Corcomroe Abbey. Travel onto Killarney via the Cliffs of Moher to see the Ring of Kerry, then we travel onto Cork.

Day 3 Cork/ Tipperary/ Wexford

This morning we visit the Blarney Castle, kiss the Blarney stone before we travel onto Tipperary to the Rock of Cashel religious buildings from the 12th century. Visit this amazing site including the Cathedral Round Tower and Cormac Chapel. Travel onto Wexford and visit Selskar Abbey and the remains the 14th century tower house and 19th century Church, then onto St Iberius Church dating back to the 17th century and remodelled in 1760 and features fantastic Georgian interior and superb acoustics. The land has been used for houses of worship since Norse times.

Day 4 Wexford/ Glendalough/ Dublin



Travel to Glendalough one of Ireland's most famous monastic sites established in the 6th century by St Kevin. Guided tour of site including the Round Tower the Cathedral and St Kevin's kitchen

Christian City tour of Dublin including and St Patrick's Anglican Cathedral and a visit to the Book of Kells at Dublin Trinity College.

Day 5 Dublin

This morning we depart Dublin and continue to Baltinglass to visit the ruins of a Cistercian Abbey then onto Castledermot and visit the remains of a Franciscan Abbey.

Day 6 Dublin/ Manchester / Lincoln



Direct flight with Air Lingus from Dublin to Manchester or Leeds / Bradford Airport.

Travel to Epworth the charming market town and birth place of John and Charles Wesley. Visit the Old Rectory the home of the Wesley family to learn more about the bustling early years of the Wesley brothers, St Andrews Church and Wesley Memorial Methodist Church.

Visit Lincoln Cathedral and the Magna Carter.

Day 7 Lincoln/ Peak District/ Staffordshire/ Oxford

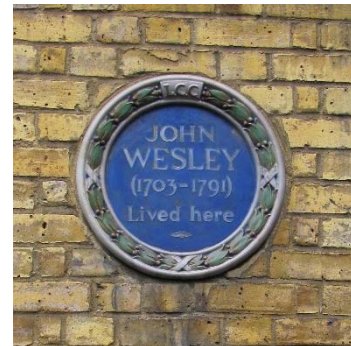
Travel through the peak district one of England's national parks to Staffordshire visit Mow Cop noteworthy as the birthplace of primitive Methodism take a tour of the Wedgewood Potteries and learn about the links between Wesley and Josiah Wedgewood. Visit Bishop Asbury's Cottage and take a private tour of the home which was once home to Francis Asbury the first American Methodist Bishop.

Overnight Oxford

Day 8 Oxford/ Gloucester or Bristol

Visit Oxford the historic University town where John Wesley attended University. Combine a walking tour of the city visiting Christ Church College the college he attended and started the Holy club. Visit other significant points of note such as Lincoln College St Marys Church and University Church

Overnight Gloucester or Bristol



Day 9 Cotswolds/ Gloucester/ Bristol



Travel to Gloucester where we visit the small church from which Robert Raikes launched the Sunday school movement and where an early Women's Missionary Movement had its beginnings. It is here that George Whitfield started the revival movement. We spend the rest of the day in Bristol visiting John Wesley's Chapel the oldest Methodist building in the world and the first ever Methodist chapel and Charles Wesley's house. Explore other significant Methodist Heritage sites in the area such as St James Priory, The Brickfields Bristol Cathedral, The Lord Mayors Chapel/ St Marks and Hanham Mount.

Overnight Bristol

Day 10 Bristol/ Somerset/ London

In the morning travel the short distance to Somerset to visit the village of Pill, where both Francis Asbury and Thomas Coke set sail for America and see the plaque that celebrates the Bicentennial of the Methodist Episcopal Church.



Then onto London upon arrival enjoy and a visit to St Pauls Cathedral a site of worship for over 1,000 years and Methodist Central Hall which was built to mark the centenary of John Wesley's death.

Overnight London

Day 11 London

Explore the Wesley way taking an in depth tour of Wesley's time in London. Visit can include John Wesley's house and tomb, the museum of Methodism, Charterhouse where he went to school, Burnhill fields and the John Wesley's Conversion Place Memorial.
