Sample Petra Jordan Extension for Your Custom Designed Israel Itinerary

Day 1 - JERUSALEM, ALLENBY BRIDGE/ MADABA/ MACHAERUS/ PETRA

This morning, we transfer from Jerusalem to Jordan via the Allenby Bridge. We will meet our Jordanian guide after clearing security and customs. We drive to **Madaba**, the Moabite town of Madaba of the Bible to see the Ancient Holy Land Map. Next travel to **Machaerus** (Mukawir). Perched on a 700-meter-high hill south-west of Madaba are the ruins of the fortress of Herod the Great. Machaerus is where John the Baptist was beheaded by Herod Antipas. We continue south to **Petra**, "the Red Rose City". Dinner and overnight is in Petra. (B, D)

Day 2 - PETRA

After breakfast, we visit **Petra**, a 2000-year-old Nabatean city. We'll walk a short half-mile through the narrow passageway with cliffs on either side (called the "Siq"). At the end of the Siq appears Petra's most impressive monument, and the Treasury, a massive royal tomb carved out of the solid mountain rock. Dinner and overnight in Amman. (B, D)

Day 3 - PETRA/ AMMAN

This morning is at leisure in **Petra**. This afternoon, we depart for **Amman** and along the way we will see **Jabal Harun** (Mount Aaron) - the place where Aaron is buried. Dinner and overnight in Amman. (B, D)

Day 4 – AMMAN/ MT. NEBO/ BETHANY BEYOND THE JORDAN/ JERASH/ AMMAN AIRPORT This morning is at leisure. This afternoon we travel west to Mt. Nebo to stand where Moses stood and viewed the Holy Land. In front of the church you can take in a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea to the Mount of Olives. From here a short drive takes us to Bethany Beyond the Jordan, where tradition believes that John the Baptist would have Baptized Jesus. Then we travel to Jerash. Near Jerash the road crosses the biblical Jabbock River. It was near the Jabbock River were Jacob wrestled with the God. We will tour Jerash. This city is one of the world's best-preserved examples of Roman provincial city. It is estimated to have a population of 20,000 people, was a Decapolis city, and was one of the wealthiest cities of the Roman Empire. Dinner in Amman area, after dinner, transfer to Amman Airport for your return flights back to the USA. Transfer to Amman airport for your flight home. (B, D)

Day 5 - ARRIVE UNITED STATES

We arrive home filled with wonderful memories, a renewal of our faith and new friendships.
