Highlights: Whale Watching and Mendenhall Glacier

Alaska's spectacular whales and the Mendenhall Glacier, all in a half-day on a private boat. Whale viewing is guaranteed!

Our Juneau excursion adventure begins with a short drive to a scenic harbor. Here, we will board a mammal-friendly jet boat equipped with water jet drives to ensure a quiet underwater operation without dangerous propellers that may frighten or harm the animals. The boats have an enclosed and heated cabin, complete with indoor plumbing. In addition, the boat only holds a maximum of 40 guests. There are large viewing windows and an outdoor viewing deck, providing an up-close and personal experience while we observe and photograph the animals in their natural surroundings.

We will be on the boat for approximately two hours in an area that the whales frequent every summer.

Returning to land, we will travel further into the valley to see the only "drive up" glacier in Southeast Alaska. Once we arrive at the Visitor's Center (entrance included), we will have approximately 45 minutes to explore on our own. We can walk around the Visitor's Center, which has an elevated view of the glacier across the Mendenhall Lake, or view exhibits, as well as a short film about the Juneau Ice Fields. For those guests feeling more adventurous, there are several hiking paths around the lake area, including Photo Point Trail, which winds along Mendenhall Lake to an unobstructed view of the glacier face. At the appointed time, meet our guide for the trip back to town.

Highlights: Japonski Island, Silver Bay, Fortress Bear Habitat, Totem Park and Sitka Village

Russian word for Japanese) Island's rich history and wildlife. Although wildlife sightings are not guaranteed, we will most likely see eagles, sea lions, otters, and various other animals during the tour.

Our tour continues with a scenic drive to Silver Bay, where we will learn of its rich history and be amazed by the scenery and photo opportunities.

Next, we're on to the "Fortress of the Bear." Here, we will have the opportunity to witness the distinctive brown bear in a naturalized setting, while gaining a thorough education on the species itself. The three-quarter acre habitat is complete with covered viewing areas, as well as an adjacent public farm.

We continue to the Sitka National Historical Park, also known as Totem Park. We will stand on a bridge over Indian River and learn about the salmon and their life cycle, then take a walk in the amazing old growth rain forest. Hear about the native culture as we view the totem art and scenery.

Our excursion concludes with a stop in the quaint village of Sitka. We will have time on our own to explore the historic square and to visit St. Michael's Cathedral, a fine example of Russian architecture. We return to our ship, a five-minute walk to the port.
