

DAY 1 - FRIDAY, OCTOBER 22: PHOENIX/ TEL AVIV

We depart for Israel from the Phoenix International Airport for our flights to Tel Aviv.

DAY 2 - SATURDAY, OCTOBER 23: TEL AVIV/ GALILEE

We arrive late this afternoon at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel Aviv and drive from the Mediterranean to the shores of the **Sea of Galilee**. Sitting 690 feet below sea level and flanked by mountains, the Sea of Galilee becomes our home for the next four nights as we check into Magdala Guesthouse, surrounded by natural beauty and ancient history. Get a good night's sleep for tomorrow is a BIG day! (D)

DAY 3 - SUNDAY, OCTOBER 24: GALILEE: MOUNT OF BEAUTES, CAPERNAUM and MAGDALA

We begin our day with a stop and visit to the **Mount of Beatitudes**. If the weather permits, we will journey down the Mount on foot to feel the contours of the land and discover the flora and fauna along this well-travelled path. When Jesus was headquartered in Capernaum, He would often go into the hills to pray, and, in these hills, we not only study the **Sermon on the Mount**, but we spend some private time in this place that Jesus loved so much. Mid-morning, we descend the hill to **Capernaum**. We gather under the trees in the "backyard" of the Apostles—Peter, Andrew, James, and John— for teaching time. We end our day at **Magdala**, the home of **Mary Magdalene**. We tour the **first century synagogue** that Jesus most likely would have visited as well as **Duc In Altum** (Luke 5:4 "put out into the water"), the new Conference Center dedicated to the women of the Bible. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 - MONDAY, OCTOBER 25: GALILEE: CAESAREA MARITIMA, MT. CARMEL and MEGGIDO

After breakfast, we drive to **Caesarea by the Sea** (Caesarea Maritima), the **deep-water port built by Herod the Great**. Caesarea was the **home of the Roman garrison** and of **Pontius Pilate**. We will explore the ancient ruins and be taught in the same outdoor theatre that is mentioned in the Book of Acts. Then we drive to **Mt. Carmel**, where Elijah prayed, and God defeated 450 prophets of Baal with fire from heaven (1 Kings 18). We travel to the Lower Galilee region to visit the **UNESCO World Heritage Site of Megiddo**, which was at the crossroads of ancient trade and military routes from Egypt to Asia Minor. At the museum will view several models, which includes the **Tel** model dating back to the 10th century BC reign of King Solomon. This evening we return to the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight (B, D)

DAY 5 - TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26: GALILEE: MT. TABOR, SEPPHORIS, CANA, NAZARETH and SAIL ON THE SEA OF GALILEE

After breakfast, we depart Galilee and drive to **Mount Tabor** located in Lower Galilee, at the eastern end of the Jezreel Valley. We take taxis to the top of the mountain where the elevation provides an utterly commanding view of all of Galilee. It was here that Jesus revealed the wonderful power of presence in communion with saints of the past (Moses and Elijah). We visit the **Church of the Transfiguration**

and have teaching and time of prayer in the garden. We proceed to the **national park of Sepphoris**, which was once an important city in the Temple and post-Temple period, to see the **famous mosaic** of the "Mona



Lisa of the Galilee." Also, here is a **Byzantine Era Synagogue** with a **mosaic of the Zodiac signs**. Our next stop is **Cana**, the location of **Jesus's first Miracle** (John 2) and the **famous wedding church**. We proceed to the city of **Nazareth**; the place Jesus spend his childhood. We visit the **Church of Annunciation** and **Mary's Well**. Our day concludes on the Nazareth ridge with the story of Luke, Chapter 5. We return to the Sea of Galilee to board our vessel for a **cruise on the Sea of Galilee** that will take us gently into the sunset. We conclude our day with a visit to the **Jesus Boat Museum** where we will see a **2,000-year-old fishing boat**, which once sailed the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 6 - WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 27: GALILEE/ MT. GILBOA/ BEIT SHEAN/ BETHLEHEM/ JERUSALEM

This is our "moving day." We depart the Galilee area and will be heading to **Gideon Springs** on the foot of **Mt. Gilboa** to learn the story of the site. Then we will visit **Beit Shean**, one of the **best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities**. This is where King Saul and his sons' bodies were hung from the city walls after being defeated by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10-12). We drive via the **Jordan Valley** and make our way to **Bethlehem** and visit the **Church of the Nativity**. We will also visit **Shepherds' Field Chapel** to sing Christmas carols as a group. We travel to **Jerusalem** and check into the Dan Panorama Hotel, our home for the next four nights. (B, D)



DAY 7 - THURSDAY, OCTOBER 28: JERUSALEM: MT. OF OLIVES, GETHSEMANE, UPPER ROOM, SOUTHERN STEPS, PILGRIMS' ROAD and WESTERN WALL

We begin our Jerusalem pilgrimage on the **Mount of Olives** where we look directly across to the **Temple Mount** and celebrate the same view as pilgrims have for the past 3,000 years. We enter Jerusalem and walk down the same path that Jesus took when he entered the city on Palm Sunday. Halfway down the hill we reach the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the night in prayer. Here, Jesus was arrested and began his journey to the cross. This is a profoundly holy place, and we have teaching and time of private prayer in the garden itself. We make our way to the **Church**

of the Agony, for teaching. We enter the **Old City via Herod's Gate** and make our way along the **Way of the Cross** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. This afternoon, we visit the **Upper Room**, also known as the **Cenacle**, and is perhaps best known as the traditional site of the **Last Supper**. Our next visit is the **Southern Steps** and experience the virtual room at **Davidson Center** and the **two-millennia-old Pilgrims' Road** excavation in the **City of David**. Our day concludes at the **Western Wall**, where we will be able to pray for all your special intentions. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)



DAY 8 - FRIDAY, OCTOBER 29: JERUSALEM: EIN GEDI, MASADA, DEAD SEA and QUMRAN

After early breakfast, we depart Jerusalem and make our way east to the **lowest place on Earth**, the Dead Sea. Our first stop is at **Ein Gedi**, a **lush oasis**, which served as **David's hideout** when he was on the run from King Saul. Here, we retell the story of David sparing Saul's life and **hike to the first waterfall** in this **nature reserve**. (1 Samuel 24). Next, we visit **Masada**, where the Jews made their last stand against the Romans after the fall of Jerusalem in 70 A.D., and we ride the cable car to the top of the fortress built by Herod the Great. Here, we explore the archeology, and enjoy a panoramic view of the Dead Sea framed by the mountains of Moab to the east. This afternoon, we **enjoy lunch** and a **swim** at a **Dead Sea hotel**. On our way back up to Jerusalem, we stop at **Qumran** and the **settlement of the first century sect** known as the **Essenes**, authors of the **Dead Sea Scrolls**. Afterwards, we return to Jerusalem in time for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 - SATURDAY, OCTOBER 30: JERUSALEM: ST. PETER IN GALLICANTU and ISRAEL MUSEUM

After breakfast, we visit **St. Peter in Gallicantu**, for teaching. Next, we will visit the **Israel Museum**, where we view a **replica model of Jerusalem** in the time of Jesus and the **Shrine of the Book**, to learn about the discovery and revelation of the Dead Sea Scrolls. This afternoon is at leisure to explore the Old City and shopping, bargaining for olive wood and other items in the colorful markets. For those who are interested will be able to attend the English language Catholic Vigil Mass at Notre Dame chapel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 10 - SUNDAY, OCTOBER 31: JERUSALEM/ ABU GOSH/ ELAH VALLEY/ JAFFA/ TEL AVIV

After breakfast, we depart Jerusalem and drive to **Abu Gosh** to visit the **White Fathers' Church of the Resurrection** and garden space for a **teaching** on the **journey to Emmaus**. We proceed to **Elah Valley** to see the brook where **King David Slew Goliath** and to hear the story of this site. This evening we travel to **Biblical Joppa (Jaffa)** to share a **farewell dinner celebration** that will not soon be forgotten. This will be a time to share our many joys and memories, and to say goodbye to our Israel travelers who will be traveling to Petra, Jordan. Tonight, we transfer to the Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, for our flights back to the United States. (B, D)

DAY 11 - MONDAY, NOVEMBER 1: ARRIVE PHOENIX

We arrive home in Phoenix. Never again will we read the Bible in black & white; now we will read it in living color and Dolby® sound!

DAY 10 - SUNDAY, OCTOBER 31: JERUSALEM: ABU GOSH, ELAH VALLEY and JAFFA

After breakfast, we depart Jerusalem and drive to **Abu Gosh** to visit the **White Fathers' Church of the Resurrection** and garden space for a **teaching** on the **journey to Emmaus**. We proceed to **Elah Valley** to see the brook where **King David Slew Goliath** and to hear the story of this site. This evening we travel to **Biblical Joppa (Jaffa)** to share a **farewell dinner celebration** that will not soon be forgotten. This will be a time to share our many joys and memories, and to say goodbye to our Israel travelers who will be traveling to the U.S. After dinner, we return to our hotel in **Jerusalem for an overnight**. (B, D)

DAY 11 - MONDAY, NOVEMBER 1: JERUSALEM/ ALLENBY BRIDGE CROSSING/ BETHANY BEYOND THE JORDAN/ MT. NEBO/ MACHAERUS/ MADABA/ PETRA

Early this morning we depart Israel for Jordan, marveling at the breathtaking Jordanian desert landscape while learning about the history and legends of the area. After crossing the **Allenby Bridge** into Jordan, we will meet our Jordanian guide after clearing security and customs. Our first stop is to **Bethany Beyond the Jordan**, where **John the Baptist baptized Jesus**. We travel west to **Mt. Nebo**, where we will have a magnificent view of the Promised Land, as Moses saw it. We continue to **Machaerus** (Mukawir), where John the Baptist was beheaded by Herod Antipas. Our next stop is **Madaba**, the **city of mosaics** and **Moabite town** of Madaba of the **Bible**. We visit the Greek Orthodox Basilica of St. George to see the Ancient Holy Land Map, a floor mosaic dating back to the 6th century AD and a treasure of early Christianity. We continue onto **Petra, "the Red Rose City"**, which was the target of a dreadful prophecy in the book of Obadiah and it served as the capital of the ancient Nabatean Kingdom. In biblical times, Petra was part of the **Edomite Kingdom**, founded by Jacob's brother Esau. We end our day at our hotel, with dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 12 - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2: PETRA

After breakfast, we visit Petra, a **2000-year-old Nabatean city**. We will walk a short half-mile through the narrow passageway with cliffs on either side (called the **"Siq"**). At the end of the Siq appears Petra's most impressive monument, **the Treasury**, a massive royal tomb carved out of the solid mountain rock. This well-preserved monumental tomb appears in the movie "Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade." A walk further down through the **Outer Siq** with all its tombs and burial chambers brings us to one of the largest theaters in Jordan. A 3000-seat theater from the early first century is carved in the sandstone mountains at the bottom of the High Place of Sacrifice Mountain. Apparently, some sacrificial rituals had taken place here. From here, we walk uphill to the **Royal Tombs** for a great view of the **lower part of Petra** with all its **Roman remains**. We are in the heart of the Seir Mountains, Land of Edomites, mentioned in the Bible in Genesis. These mountains house the Aaron Peak, the highest in Petra and the burial place of Moses' brother Aaron. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 13 - WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 3: PETRA/ JERASH/ AMMAN

This morning we depart Petra and drive to the **ancient city of Jerash**. Near Jerash the road crosses the **biblical Jabbock River**. It was near the Jabbock River were Jacob wrestled with the God. We will tour Jerash. This city is one of the world's best-preserved examples of a **Roman provincial city**. It is estimated to have had a population of 20,000 people, was a **Decapolis city**, and was one of the wealthiest cities of the **Roman Empire**. This evening we return to **Amman for dinner at a local restaurant**. Tonight, we transfer to the Amman Airport for our flights home. (B, D)

DAY 14 - THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 4: AMMAN/ PHOENIX

We arrive home filled with wonderful memories, a renewal of our faith and new friendships. Never again will we read the Bible in black and white; now we will read it in living color and Dolby® sound!
