DAY 1 – MONDAY, MARCH 31: LOS ANGELES/ VENICE We depart Los Angeles (LAX) for our flights to Venice, Italy.

#### DAY 2 – TUESDAY, APRIL 1: VENICE ARRIVAL

We are met at Venice airport and transfer by coach to journey by private boat, to our centrally located hotel in Venice, short walking distance to Piazza San Marco. Dinner and overnight in Venice. (D)

#### DAY 3 – WEDNESDAY, APRIL 2: VENICE

Today, we meet our local guide for a half-day tour of Venice, including St. Mark's

Basilica and a visit to the Doges' Palace.

The afternoon is at leisure to shop or explore the canals by gondola. In the evening we will have a Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant, walking distance from the hotel. (B,D)

#### DAY 4 - THURSDAY, APRIL 3: VENICE/ PADUA/ FLORENCE

We depart Venice for Florence, with a stop in Padua to visit the Padova Musei Civici. Here we view Giotto's greatest fresco masterpiece in the Scrovegni Chapel (pending confirmation). Lunch is on our own. We continue to Florence for dinner and overnight. (B, D)



#### DAY 5 - FRIDAY, APRIL 4: FLORENCE

Early this morning, we will experience the magnificent jewels of Florence with a half-day guided tour, including Accademia, Duomo, Bell Tower and Uffizi, where, after the tour, we will enjoy some free time to explore one of Italy's greatest art galleries at your own pace. Dinner and overnight in Florence. (B, D)

#### DAY 6 - SATURDAY, APRIL 5: FLORENCE/ SIENA / ASSISI

After an early breakfast, we depart Florence for Assisi with a stop and visit Siena. Here we will have a half-day guided tour, which includes the Duomo and Baptistery. Our journey continues to Assisi, a beautiful medieval town and home of Sts. Francis and Clare. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B, D)



#### DAY 7 – SUNDAY, APRIL 6: ASSISI

This morning, after Bible reflection led by Dr. Bill Creasy, we will meet our local guide and begin our Assisi visit with the Basilica of Santa Chiara. St. Clare, the enthusiastic disciple of St. Francis, and St. Francis founded the order of "Poor Clares." She is buried beneath the high altar. In the Capella del Crocefisso, on the left side of the nave, hangs the "Speaking Cross," which is from the convent of San Damiano and in front of which St. Francis is said to have received the message from God to "go forth and rebuild my house." We continue with a visit to the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi. In the Lower Church, halfway along the nave, we'll walk down the stairway leading to the crypt that contains the remains of St. Francis of Assisi. Later, we journey by motor coach down to the lower town to visit the Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli, where the Porziuncola and the Transit chapels are preserved. This afternoon we return to the upper town and will have the rest of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B, D)



#### DAY 8 - MONDAY, APRIL 7: ASSISI/ ROME: ANCIENT ROME

Today, we travel to Rome, the Eternal City. This afternoon, we enjoy a guided walking tour of Ancient Rome. We visit the Mamertine prison, explore the Roman Forum, view the Arch of Constantine, and conclude with a visit to the Colosseum. We will have free time to delight in a delicious meal on our own at one of the great Italian restaurants in the heart of Rome. Overnight in Rome. (B)



## DAY 9 – TUESDAY, APRIL 8: ROME: VATICAN CITY, PAPAL CHURCHES, and CATACOMBS

This morning we will drive to the Vatican Museums. Here we begin our guided tour of these incredible collections, which includes the Sistine Chapel, with Michelangelo's stunning frescos. We will also visit St. Peter's Basilica, the greatest of all churches in Christendom and built on the site where St. Peter was martyred. We continue with visits to St. John Lateran, Saint Mary Major's, St. Paul Outside-The-Walls, and catacombs. These four 'main' churches will have Holy Doors opened by the Pope and will remain open throughout the Jubilee year 2025. We are free this evening to explore Rome's magnificent cuisine and fine wine on our own. Overnight in Rome. (B)

#### DAY 10 - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 9: ROME: PAPAL AUDIENCE

Wednesday morning is traditionally dedicated to the Papal Audience. Today, we will wake up early and drive to St. Peter's Square to attend the Papal Audience (pending Vatican confirmation). Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure for individual sightseeing or shopping. This evening we gather in our hotel lobby and walk together to a local restaurant for our Farewell Dinner at a local Restaurant. Overnight in Rome. (B, D)

#### DAY 11 - THURSDAY, APRIL 10: ROME/ LOS ANGELES

Early this morning we transfer to the airport for our return flights home, relishing our Jubilee 2025 experience, memories, and friends. (B)

#### Note:

- This is a moderately strenuous tour, walking on ancient sites, cobblestone streets and hills. For your safety and enjoyment you should be able to walk a mile briskly and climb 100 stairs. Most sites are not handicapped accessible.
- While we do our very best to make sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/itinerary, including but not limited to delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes by your group leader and tour guide.
