DAY 1 - THURSDAY, JULY 23: LOS ANGELES/ SEATTLE

We depart Los Angeles (LAX) for our flight to Seattle. Upon arrival at Seattle Tacoma International we will be transferred to our hotel, located in the downtown Seattle. Settle in, refresh, and perhaps enjoy an evening stroll to nearby Pike Place Market or the vibrant theater district. Rest well, tomorrow, our Alaskan journey begins. This evening stroll to the vibrant theater district or visit nearby Pike Place Market for a taste of local style and flavor. Enjoy a self-hosted dinner at one of the market's wonderful restaurants.



DAY 2 - FRIDAY, JULY 24: EMBARKATION SEATTLE

After breakfast, we will transfer from our Hotel to the Seattle Cruise Terminal. Step aboard the revolutionary **Celebrity Edge®**, where modern luxury meets breathtaking design. DAY 3 - SATURDAY, JULY 25: AT SEA

DAY 4 - SUNDAY, JULY 26: KETCHIKAN, ALASKA

Known as the "Salmon Capital of the World", Ketchikan offers a rich blend of Native culture and frontier spirit. Explore the world's largest collection of totem poles, stroll historic Creek Street, or venture into the lush Tongass National Forest. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 – MONDAY, JULY 27: ENDICOTT ARM, DAWES GLACIER & JUNEAU ALASKA

Today is a highlight of the journey. Sail through the **30 mile Endicott Arm Fjord**, flanked by granite cliffs, waterfalls, and drifting icebergs. At its end lies the magnificent **Dawes Glacier** — 600 feet tall and half a mile wide. Watch in awe as massive chunks of ice calve into the sea, a vivid reminder of God's power in creation.

Juneau, Alaska's capital city offers adventure at every turn. Visit the Mendenhall Glacier, embark on a whale-watching excursion, or ride the Mount Roberts Tramway for sweeping views. In the evening, gather for fellowship and reflection on the day's wonders. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 - TUESDAY, JULY 28: SKAGWAY, INSIDE PASSAGE ALASKA

Step back into the Gold Rush era in this charming frontier town. Ride the historic **White Pass & Yukon Route Railway**, winding through mountain passes and waterfalls, or explore the Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 - WEDNESDAY, JULY 29: DAY AT SEA

Enjoy panoramic views, meet your fellow travelers, and and enjoy the splendor of Alaska. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 - THURSDAY, JULY 30: VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA

An evening call in this elegant harbor city offers time to explore the **Butchart Gardens**, stroll the Inner Harbour, or enjoy a taste of British charm before we return to Seattle. (B,L,D)

DAY 9 - FRIDAY, JULY 31: DISEMBARK & SEATTLE SIGHTS

After disembarking, we'll enjoy a relaxed **Seattle Highlights Tour** by private coach. Our journey begins with a reflective stop at **St. James Cathedral**, followed by sweeping skyline views from **Kerry Park**. We'll then visit the **Ballard Locks and Fish Ladder**, where salmon make their way upstream. Then we will transfer to the lively **Pike Place Market** for shopping and self hosted lunch with plenty of dining options. Along the way, we'll take in the character of **Pioneer Square** and the **International District**. The tour concludes with a timely drop-off at **Seattle Airport** flight to Los Angeles. (B)
