Day 1 – Monday, March 8 | Depart Newark

Our pilgrimage begins as we board an overnight flight from Newark Airport to the Holy Land. Over the next ten days, the Bible will come to life in new and powerful ways.

Day 2 – Tuesday, March 9 | Arrival in the Holy Land: Tel Aviv/Hadera

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we'll be warmly welcomed by our guide and driver and transferred to our hotel along the beautiful Mediterranean coast. Our first evening is in Hadera, where the gentle rhythm of the sea and the comfort of our accommodation provide a peaceful space to rest and prepare; tomorrow will be a big day! Dinner at our hotel. (D)

Day 3 – Wednesday, March 10 | Hadera/Megiddo/Nazareth/Mt. Arbel/Sea of Galilee

Our pilgrimage begins with a drive north toward the Carmel Range to **Tel Megiddo**, strategically located on the ancient Via Maris. After a primer on biblical archaeology and a walk through the water system, we continue to **Nazareth**, Jesus' childhood home. After visiting the **Church of the Annunciation**, we will stop at the **Precipice** for teaching and a panoramic view of the Jezreel Valley. Later this afternoon, we'll ascend **Mt. Arbel** for an overview of the Sea of Galilee. At 690' below sea level, the **Sea of Galilee** is surrounded by rolling hills and dark basalt cliffs. For the next three nights, we'll be settled in this scenic and relaxing lakeside setting. Dinner is at our hotel. (B, D)

Day 4 – Thursday, March 11 | Bethsaida/Capernaum/Mt. of Beatitudes/Tabgha/Jordan River

This morning we begin with a visit to the ancient "**Jesus Boat**," a remarkable first-century vessel that offers a tangible connection to the world of Jesus and His disciples. The day then unfolds along the shores of the Sea of Galilee as we explore **Bethsaida**, hometown of several of the apostles, and **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' Galilean ministry. Following a memorable lakeside self-hosted lunch featuring the traditional "St. Peter's Fish," we'll visit the **Mount of Beatitudes** and have time for personal reflection on Jesus' teaching. Then we'll visit **Tabgha** (loaves and fishes) and the **Church of the Primacy**, where Jesus restored Peter. Our day concludes at Yardenit on the **Jordan River**, where those who wish may participate in baptism or the renewal of baptismal vows in this meaningful and memorable setting. Then we return to our hotel for dinner. (B, D)

Day 5 – Friday, March 12 | Upper Galilee/Tel Dan/Banias (Caesarea Philippi)/Magdala

This morning we'll travel north through Upper Galilee to explore **Tel Dan** and view the gate of ancient **Laish**. Then it's on to **Banias** (Caesarea Philippi), where Peter confessed Jesus as the Messiah, and Jesus declared that the gates of Hades would not prevail against his Church. Returning to the Sea of Galilee for the afternoon, we visit **Magdala**, a beautifully preserved archaeological site associated with Mary Magdalene, offering unique insights into first-century life. We conclude the day with a memorable **boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee, experiencing the beauty of the lake that served as the backdrop for so much of Christ's earthly ministry before returning to our hotel for dinner. (B, D)



Day 6 – Saturday, March 13 | Galilee/Jordan Valley/Beit Shean/Dead Sea

Departing the Sea of Galilee, we travel southward through the **Jordan Valley**, stopping at **Beit Shean**, one of the most impressive ancient cities and archaeological sites in Israel. David's lament over the deaths of King Saul and Jonathan is recited here. Driving through **Jericho**, we will pause to enjoy a self-hosted lunch before continuing to our Dead Sea hotel for an overnight stay. Our stay at the **Dead Sea** offers a unique opportunity to float in its mineral-rich waters and, if you choose, to treat yourself to the hotel's spa services. Dinner is at our hotel. (B, D)

Day 7 – Sunday, March 14 | Dead Sea/Masada/Ein Gedi/Qumran/Jerusalem

We check out early to ascend **Masada**, the dramatic desert fortress built by Herod. We'll ride the cable car round-trip to the top of the fortress, explore the archaeological site, and enjoy a panoramic view of the Dead Sea, framed by the mountains of Moab to the east. Following our descent, we will visit **Ein Gedi National Park** (David and Saul) and hike to the beautiful waterfall, keeping watch for the **Ibex** (Mountain Goat) and **Hyrax**.

(Rock Badger). Next, we stop at **Qumran** for a self-hosted lunch. Here you can view the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, making this site one of the most significant archaeological locations in the region. Finally, we ascend to **Jerusalem**, pausing at the Haas Promenade for an overview and a “**Patriarchal Welcome**” (bread and wine) to the Holy City before proceeding to our hotel. (B, D)



Day 8 – Monday, March 15 | Jerusalem/Mount of Olives/Gethsemane/Old City

Our first day in Jerusalem begins atop the **Mount of Olives**. From this panoramic overlook, we will follow in the footsteps of Jesus on the **Palm Sunday Road** down toward the Kidron Valley. We will pause for teaching at **Dominus Flevit Chapel**, then continue to the **Garden of Gethsemane**, a place of ancient olive trees and profound reflection in the **Church of All Nations**. Then, entering the **Old City** through the **Lion’s Gate** (Sheep Gate, St. Stephen’s Gate), we’ll explore sacred sites, including the **Pool of Bethesda**, **Church of St. Anne**, the **Via Dolorosa**, and the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. This day invites deep reflection on the final days of Christ’s earthly ministry. We’ll exit the Old City through **Jaffa Gate** and return to our hotel for dinner. (B, D)

Day 9 – Tuesday, March 16 | Jerusalem/Temple Mount/Western Wall/City of David

This morning we’ll enter the Dung Gate for an early visit to the **Temple Mount**, where centuries of history, faith, and tradition converge. We then continue to the **Western Wall** (Wailing Wall), the holiest site in Judaism, followed by a tour through the **Western Wall Tunnels**, where layers of ancient Jerusalem are revealed beneath the Muslim Quarter of the Old City. After a self-hosted lunch in the Old City, we will walk through the Herodian Quarter and then on the **Southern Steps**, where pilgrims once ascended to the Temple. We’ll continue to the nearby excavation of the **City of David**, where we’ll splash through **Hezekiah’s Tunnel** (optional) to the **Pool of Siloam** and walk along the ancient **Pilgrims Road**, tracing the footsteps of those who journeyed to worship in Jerusalem long ago. Then we’ll meet our coach and return to the hotel for dinner. (B, D)

Day 10 – Wednesday, March 17 | Bethlehem/Shepherds’ Fields/Yad Vashem/Israel Museum

Today we journey to Bethlehem (pending confirmation) to visit the **Church of the Nativity**, which marks the birthplace of Christ. Next door are **St. Catherine’s Church** and **St. Jerome’s Grotto**. After a self-hosted lunch in **Shepherds’ Fields**, we will drive to **Yad Vashem**, Israel’s Holocaust Memorial, and better understand why the world must never forget. Then we’ll continue to the **Israel Museum**, the Second Temple Model, and the **Shrine of the Book**, home to the Dead Sea Scrolls. Dinner will be at our hotel. (B, D)

Day 11 – Thursday, March 18 | Jerusalem/Caesarea Maritima/Tel Aviv

After breakfast and checkout, we begin our final day at the **Garden Tomb** by acknowledging Jesus’ resurrection in a Communion Service. Then, leaving Jerusalem, we’ll drive west toward the Mediterranean coast to walk through the extensive excavations at **Caesarea Maritima**, site of several biblical events, including a two-year imprisonment of the Apostle Paul. After strolling along the shore of the Mediterranean, you may enjoy a self-hosted lunch in one of several available restaurants. Before leaving the site, we will gather for a final teaching, which will bring our pilgrimage to a memorable conclusion. En route to the airport, we will have a **farewell dinner** and time to share and celebrate all we have experienced together. Then we’ll transfer to Ben Gurion Airport to check in for our return flight to the United States. (B, D)

Day 12 – Friday, March 19 | USA/Return Home

We arrive back in the United States and clear customs at Newark Liberty International Airport, NJ, then head home, carrying with us not only memories but also a renewed, living connection to the Bible and the land of Jesus.

NOTE:

- This is a moderately strenuous tour, walking on ancient archaeological sites, cobblestone streets and hills. For your safety and enjoyment, you should be able to walk a mile briskly and easily climb 100 stairs. Most sites are not handicapped accessible and cannot be accessed by persons with limited mobility.
- While we do our best to make sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/itinerary or require its alteration, including but not limited to air carrier changes, delays, weather, traffic, political climate, time constraints, other conditions beyond our control, or changes by your group hosts and/or guides.
