Day 1 – Sunday, April 4: Los Angeles/ Dublin

Today we depart Los Angeles on our overnight flights to Ireland. As we cross the Atlantic, we begin preparing heart and mind for a journey that will explore Scripture, history, and faith shaped by place.

Day 2 – Monday, April 5: Dublin: Malahide Castle and Gardens

Upon arrival this afternoon at **Dublin Airport**, we are warmly welcomed by our local guide and driver. We begin with a visit to **Malahide Castle & Gardens**, a beautifully preserved and picturesque estate that offers a gentle introduction to Ireland's layered history. We continue with a **panoramic drive through Dublin City**, providing our first glimpse of the capital before checking in to our hotel, our home for the next two nights. This evening we gather for our **welcome dinner** in our hotel, officially beginning our journey together. (D)



Day 3 – Tuesday, April 6: Dublin: Scripture, Learning and the Church

Today we explore Dublin's rich spiritual and intellectual heritage. At **Trinity College**, we walk the historic campus and view the **Book of Kells**, one of the most treasured illuminated Gospel manuscripts in the world. Dr. Creasy will offer insight into the central role of Scripture in early Christian Ireland. We continue to **St. Patrick's Cathedral**, built on a site associated with Ireland's patron saint, with time for reflection and prayer. This evening we enjoy a festive **Irish cultural experience** at **Johnnie Fox's Hooley Show**, combining music, dance, and hospitality. (B, D)



Day 4 – Wednesday, April 7: Dublin/ Wicklow/ Glendalough/ Baltinglass Abbey / Kilkenny

After breakfast, we depart Dublin and travel south into the **Wicklow Mountains National Park**, often called the "Garden of Ireland." We then arrive at **Glendalough**, the sixth-century monastic settlement founded by **St. Kevin**; one of Ireland's most important early Christian saints and spiritual figures.

Walking among lakes, stone churches, and round towers, we explore themes of solitude, prayer, and ascetic devotion. This afternoon, we enjoy an **Irish Sheepdogs demonstration**, which offers a glimpse of rural life. Our next visit is the atmospheric ruins of **Baltinglass Abbey**, which are among the most impressive surviving Cistercian remains in Ireland, known for their 12th century Romanesque architecture. Late this afternoon we arrive in County Kilkenny, one of Ireland's best-preserved medieval towns. We gather tonight for dinner at our hotel. (B, D)

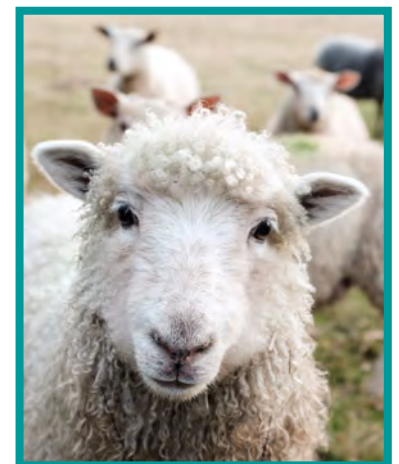
Day 5 – Thursday, April 8: Kilkenny Castle/ Rock of Cashel/ Dingle

Our day begins with a visit to **Kilkenny Castle**, once the seat of the powerful Butler family and dynasty who dominated Irish political, military, and social life for centuries. We drive west to stop and view the dramatic **Rock of Cashel**, one of Ireland's most iconic sacred sites, where kingship and Christianity converged. Here, Dr. Creasy reflects on faith and authority in medieval Ireland. By evening, we arrive in **Dingle**, perched on the westernmost edge of Ireland and surrounded by cliffs, rolling green hills, and the wild sweep of the Atlantic. We check in to our hotel for a two-night stay. This evening we gather for a relaxing dinner at our hotel. (B, D)



Day 6 – Friday, April 9: Dingle Peninsula and Gallarus Oratory

Today we explore the windswept beauty of the **Dingle Peninsula**, one of Ireland's most evocative landscapes. We encounter early Christian remains, including the remarkably preserved **Gallarus Oratory**, standing alone against sea and sky. In the afternoon, we visit **beehive huts**, known as *clocháin*, and a local farm bringing early Irish and monastic life vividly into focus. The day ends back in Dingle, with time to enjoy this charming seaside town for a self-hosted dinner at a local restaurant. (B)



Day 7 – Saturday, April 10: Dingle/ Clare/ Cliffs of Moher/ the Burren/ Galway

After breakfast, we depart Dingle and board the **Shannon Ferry** to cross the Shannon Estuary between Killimer in County Clare and Tarbert in County Kerry, a short



but scenic link along the Wild Atlantic Way. We arrive in County Clare and stand atop the breathtaking **Cliffs of Moher**, rising dramatically above the Atlantic. We continue through the stark limestone landscape of **the Burren** (*Boirinn*, “rocky place”), rich in geological and spiritual symbolism. This evening we arrive in **Galway**, where the River Corrib flows into Galway Bay and the Atlantic. It is often called Ireland’s Cultural Heart and the City of Tribes. Dinner is at our hotel. (B, D)

Day 8 – Sunday, April 11: Galway/ Connemara/ Kylemore Abbey/ Killary Fjord/ Westport

This morning we travel from Galway northwest to **Connemara National Park**, following one of Ireland’s most beautiful road journeys. The route carries us out of the lively coastal city and into a landscape of mountains, lakes, and wide-open bogs. We stop to visit **Kylemore Abbey**, a Benedictine monastery set beside a tranquil lake and mountains.

This afternoon we experience a **Killary Fjord cruise and tour**, sailing along Ireland’s only true fjord and taking in some of the most unforgettable scenery and dramatic landscapes in the west of Ireland. Continuing



north we arrive in **Westport**, where we will have a two-night stay. Dinner is at our hotel. (B, D)

Day 9 – Monday, April 12: Westport: Knock Shrine and Murrisk Abbey

After breakfast, we travel to County Mayo to visit **Knock Shrine**, Ireland’s National Marian Shrine and one of the world’s great pilgrimage sites, where an apparition was witnessed in 1879. It is a place of hope and healing, and time is given for prayer and quiet reflection. We continue to **Murrisk Abbey**, a beautifully preserved Augustinian ruin located at the base of **Croagh Patrick**, long associated with St. Patrick’s forty-day fast. This afternoon we return to our hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore Westport’s warm atmosphere on our own and enjoy its excellent selection of local restaurants. Tonight, dinner is self-hosted. (B)

Day 10 – Tuesday, April 13: Westport/ Offaly/ Clonmacnoise/ Dublin

We depart Westport and travel east into the central Irish county of Offaly. Here we visit

Clonmacnoise, situated on the left bank of the River Shannon and one of Ireland’s most important early Christian centers,



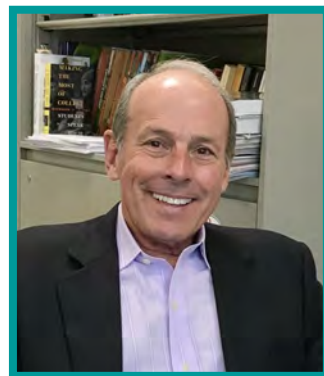
founded by **St. Ciarán** in the sixth century. The site is surrounded by round towers, high crosses, and ancient grave slabs, creating one of the most evocative monastic landscapes in Ireland. Dr. Creasy will teach and reflect on Ireland’s missionary legacy. We continue to Dublin and check in to our hotel. This evening we gather for our **farewell dinner** in our hotel, a special time to share our joys and memories of our journey together. (B, D)

Day 11 – Wednesday, April 14: Dublin/ Los Angeles

After breakfast, we transfer to **Dublin Airport** for our return flights home. We depart carrying with us not only a deeper understanding of Scripture and history, but also a renewed appreciation for the enduring Christian witness of Ireland. (B)

Note:

- This is a moderately strenuous tour, walking on ancient sites, cobblestone streets and hills. For your safety and enjoyment you should be able to walk a mile briskly and climb 100 stairs. Most sites are not handicapped accessible.
- While we do our very best to make sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/itinerary, including but not limited to delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes by your group leader and tour guide.
